The **CERTIFICATE OF DESIGNATION** allows you to proceed with the permit application process for hazardous waste storage at the proposed location. The process is the same as the Part A and Part B application requirements of 40 CFR 270. As a recycling facility, you are also required to apply for a written determination (NAC 444.8455). Both applications may be submitted concurrently, although it may be advisable, in the interest of time, to submit the written determination prior to the Part A and Part B applications.
